<b>General Description:</b>	The Maintenance Technician will be responsible for routine maintenance and emergency repairs performed to ensure that the plant operates reliably, efficiently, & at high throughput in order to maximize EBITDA.
<b>Work Schedule:</b>	The Maintenance Technician position is a Monday - Friday position with a minimum of 40 hours expected. There may be times when weekend or holiday operations are necessary and the Maintenance Technician may be asked to work after normal hours. The Maintenance Technician is a member of the maintenance team and will be expected to comply with a rotational on-call schedule.
<b>Essential Duties:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work closely with Operations to facilitate repair work in process areas</li> <li>• Perform preventative and predictive maintenance procedures</li> <li>• Assist Maintenance Manager with planned and emergency repairs and with troubleshooting activities</li> <li>• Play an active role in the plant housekeeping program</li> <li>• Actively participate in safety, health, and environmental programs</li> <li>• Other duties as assigned</li> </ul>
<b>Work Environment:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Exposure, within OSHA limits, to process chemicals, solvents, and greases</li> <li>• Exposure, within OSHA limits, to dusty environments</li> <li>• Work in all weather conditions: heat, cold, rain, snow</li> <li>• Work at ambient to elevated temperatures</li> <li>• Work near moving mechanical parts</li> <li>• Exposure, within OSHA limits, to high noise environments</li> </ul>
